Praxis Score Equivalencies

- 1) 522 composite Praxis I score accepted if Reading & Writing scores are at or above the stated NC passing level
- 2) Composite score (SAT Reading & Math; ACT English & Math) – SAT at least 1100 or ACT at least 24 – exempted from Praxis I
- 3) SAT Reading at least 550 or ACT English at least 24 – exempted from Praxis I Reading & Writing
- 4) SAT Math at least 550 or ACT Math at least 24 – exempted from Praxis I Math

Admission Process

Meeting the above requirements does not guarantee admission to the CD Program. The CD Program can only admit a limited number of students each Fall and Spring. Application closing dates are October 1 for Spring, March 1 for Summer or Fall, and June 10 for Fall if space is available. Final admission decisions will be made after semester grades are officially recorded. Students may apply for admission a maximum of three times.
