Nine hours of English major courses can meet humanities requirement of twelve hours; six hours of literature AND either English 2170 or Foreign Language 1040 or 1050 (or 1060) (also required to complete Foreign Language). The remaining three hours must be a fine arts. THR 2610 will meet the fine arts requirement.

2.0 major GPA is required for graduation. Major GPA calculation will include all courses taken in the major department, plus any other courses under III. Minimum of 18 semester hours of courses taken to fulfill major requirements must be courses offered by Appalachian. No more than 40 semester hours of courses in English may be counted toward the BA Degree.
