2.0 major GPA is required for graduation. Major GPA calculation will include all courses taken in the major department, plus any other courses under III. Minimum of 18 semester hours of courses taken to fulfill major requirements must be courses offered by Appalachian. No more than 40 semester hours of English courses may be counted toward the BA Degree.

To enter the Professional Writing concentration, students must: Complete ENG 3090 with a grade of B- or better; Have an entrance conference with a member of the professional writing faculty, one who will also serve as academic advisor for each student in the concentration.

To remain active in the concentration, students must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 in the concentration (Areas A, B, & C).
