ENTREPRENEURSHIP MINOR (355)

Students **not majoring in the College of Business** may earn an entrepreneurship minor by completing the following 15 hours of coursework:

I. Required courses (12 hours):

ACC 1050	Survey of Accounting.....	3 hrs. (Six hours of ACC 2100 + ACC 2110 can substitute for ACC 1050)
BUS 1050	Introduction to Business.....	3 hrs.
FIN 3010	Survey of Finance.....	3 hrs.
MGT 3060	Opportunity and Entrepreneurship.....	3 hrs.

II. One elective course from the following:.....3 hrs.

MGT 3170	Fostering and Managing Creativity (<i>on demand</i>)
MGT 3190	International Entrepreneurship (prereq: MGT 3060 or permission of instructor)(<i>fall only</i>)
MGT 3650	Social Entrepreneurship (prereq: MGT 3060 or permission of instructor)(<i>spring only</i>)
MGT 3630	Introduction to Organizational Behavior
CIS 3710	Emerging Technologies

Students are advised to take all 1000/2000 level courses prior to the 3000 level courses in the minor. Students not admitted to the College of Business may take, at most, five business courses at the 3000/4000 level (unless more courses are required by a business minor or non-business major). Students must have 57 hours to take 3000 level COB core courses, 60 hours to take any other 3000 level COB course, and 90 hours to take any 4000 level COB course. Students not admitted to the COB must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 to take 3000/4000 level business classes. In addition to other prerequisites, a minimum grade of “C” in a WID (Writing in the Discipline) course is required prior to taking any 4000 level business courses. **A minimum overall GPA of 2.0 is required for the courses included in the minor.**

NO MORE THAN ONE BUSINESS MINOR CAN BE DECLARED BY A NON-BUSINESS MAJOR.
