The Bachelor of Science in Social Work (B.S.W.) degree consists of 74 semester hours to include the following: Forty-five (45) semester hours of professional core courses in social work, including field work placements and social work electives; twenty-nine (29) semester hours of related cognate courses in several departments and disciplines.
